

I want to give the one who was hired last the same as I gave you. ¹⁵ Don't I have the right to do what I want with my own money? Or are you envious because I am generous?' ¹⁶ So the last will be first, and the first will be last."

The school theme this year is "Sent to Serve." It is based on Matthew 20:28 which states, "The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." One of the many ways that we can "serve" is by helping a friend in need. Each quarter throughout the 2020-2021 school year, our school will be participating in an activity to benefit various ministries. Our St. Paul's Lutheran School and Youth Group have teamed up to help the ministry at Camp Lutherhaven for the 1st quarter.

Like so many other ministries, businesses, and families, Camp Lutherhaven has been, and continues to be significantly impacted by COVID-19. Lutherhaven has already lost over \$30,000 because of retreat and school group cancellations this spring and summer. However, an even larger effect is the loss of over half our summer camp programs. This is significant because 65% of Lutherhaven's annual income comes from Summer Camp, so any lost weeks take an enormous financial toll. In all, Lutherhaven projects to be \$150,000 to \$250,000 below budget this year.

Lutherhaven has received a generous Matching Grant of \$50,000 from The Lutheran Foundation to help with the financial challenges associated with COVID-19. This means any gift YOU give to Lutherhaven between July 1st and December 31st will be matched 100% up to \$50,000!
